## About the Artist:

As a longtime resident of the northeast mountains, my work is inspired by stark winters, lush springs, exuberant summers, vibrant autumns. I begin paintings with watercolors applied to panels coated with encaustic gesso, laying down large swaths of color that serve as the basic architecture of each piece. I then build opaque and transparent encaustic layers, carving and scratching into them with razor blades, knives and woodcut tools to create depth and texture. Some areas are fused lightly, others involve sustained application of heat resulting in turbulent cloud-like formations. Next, I apply oils mixed with beeswax, enhancing texture and luminosity. Throughout layering and scraping processes, I attempt to conserve or unearth remnants of the underlying watercolor base. Carving, scraping and incising allow earlier layers to emerge, much the way geological and weathering processes obscure and expose evidence of prior eras, and as visual memories come into focus even as they fade away.
