# ARTIST STATEMENT

My desires to hide, to disappear, to become one with my environment while ceasing to exist as an individual are all expressed in the Disappearing Suit. There is a tension in my attempts to dematerialize into nature as the blocky, digitally fabricated form of the suit contrasts with its wild surroundings. The suit is a meditation on the effects of digital immersion on our desire for connection. Similarly, my drawings record rectilinear, minimal forms that fade into their background—cubes, arches, towers. The figures in these drawings, as well as my form in the Disappearing suit, have an element of loss—loss of people and things, but also of memories—as they appear to be only partially there, or perhaps in the process of fading away. However, the figures are also fleshed out by the layers of ink that make up their background. They are located on the page and defined by their environment, perhaps in the same way that we are affected and defined by the environments we inhabit.
