ARTIST'S STATEMENT

When the COVID-19 Pandemic hit, I self-quarantined at home like so many others. Feeling cut-off and disoriented, I listened to the news, watched the light change and the shadows move, and surveilled my neighbors as they walked their dogs. At first, I couldn't find it within me to paint anything. After a while I began to paint what I saw from my limited window on the world- the view from my fifth-floor balcony. I painted things I usually wouldn't notice and used aggressively cropped and sometimes vertiginous views as a way of expressing a personal and collective sense of isolation, disconnection and uncertainty.

As I continue to work on this series, I have realized that it is informed by issues broader than the current Pandemic. It is a reaction to what we are doing to nature in our cities, and more broadly in the world. Driven by a perversely oblivious desire for convenience and personal comfort, we are drowning in a sea of concrete. Then as a lifeline, we invite nature into our lives with flower pots and carefully trimmed hedges. But even within this construct, if we are mindful nature can still astonish with the beauty of sunlight on the grass and reflections on wet pavement.
