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MY WORK IS AN EXAMINATION OF TEXTURE. THE VERY NATURE OF CLAY ALLOWS ME TO EXPLORE MANY OPTIONS. EACH PIECE PLAYS WITH CONTRASTING SURFACES: ROUGH VERSES SMOOTH; MATTE VERSES SHINY; LARGE-SCALE VERSES SMALL-SCALE. THE JUX-TAPOSITION OF TEXTURES HELPS TO ADD VISUAL DEPTH AND TACTILE INTEREST. TEX-TURE ENVELOPS THE SURFACES OF NATURALISTIC FORMS. THEY ARE AN INVITATION TO TOUCH. AS YOU RUN YOUR HANDS OVER, THE SENSATION IS A REMINDER OF A PLACE YOU ONCE ENJOYED.

COLOR IS ALSO AN IMPORTANT ELEMENT IN MY WORK. I USE COLOR TO ENHANCE THE TEXTURAL QUALITY. DIFFERENT ASPECTS OF COLOR SUCH AS VALUE AND INTENSITY AF-FECT HOW THE PIECE IS PERCEIVED. COLOR STIMULATES OUR RESPONSE MECHANISM. IT ELICITS EMOTIONS ON A SUBCONSCIOUS LEVEL. THE TACTILE AND VISUAL EXPERI-ENCE IS HEIGHTENED WITH A FEW ADJUSTMENTS IN HOW COLOR IS APPLIED.

I HOPE THAT MY WORK WILL BRING A SENSE OF WONDER AND CURIOSITY. THE COMBI-NATION OF FAMILIAR FORMS AND TEXTURES WILL CAUSE YOU TO MARVEL AT THINGS YOU NOTICE IF YOU TAKE THE TIME TO SLOW DOWN AND EXPERIENCE THE WORLD AROUND YOU.
