Statement

Patricia Liverman

In my work, I use oil paint to explore ideas around time, change, and perception. Using thick layers of oil pulled from previously painted canvases, I create new works that carry with them a history of the paintings that preceded them. Below the visible surface, the oil continues to stratify and evolve, changes that can only be known once freed from the canvas. Juxtaposing chance and choice, I reveal the layers once hidden from view and integrate the newly exposed paint into fragmented or undulant topographies. I am fascinated by the discovery that occurs each time I pull the paint from the canvas. I reuse the same previously painted canvases repeatedly as the starting point for my work, finding a new layer below each time.

Engaging in this process allows me to consider what can be perceived and what is hidden and enables me to work with paint as a tangible material. In recent years, I have been more sculptural in my approach, constructing works that suggest geological formations and excavated remains. I'm fascinated by the hidden forces and histories just beneath the surface of the earth.

Drape is part of a series of works inspired by the formation of mountains where tectonic plates converge and compress, creating drape-like folds. Additionally, the work alludes to a cover or shroud and draws inspiration from the carved draperies used in classical sculpture to conceal – or reveal – the body beneath.
